




1. Start colored side up. Fold in half and unfold.




2. Bring point A to point B. Make the crease sharp only near the upper paper edge.




3. Pinch the lower layer of paper at indicated intersection. Unfold.




4. The pinch marks one-third of the paper's edge. Repeat steps 2-3 at other 3 corners.




5. Turn to the other side. Creating markings on white side allows them to be better visible on colored side.




6. Valley fold sides to the markers.




7. Turn over.




8. Fold edges to meet the middle crease.




9. Fold the other two edges to middle crease.




10. Turn over



11. Valley fold the 12. Valley fold in half. 13. Open the unit.



14. Finished unit. You can make a sharp crease below the upper triangular part (as in the image) for a stronger connection between units or leave this surface curved.
